## Town of Mount Morris Special Meeting September 23, 2021

At 5:00 p.m. Supervisor DiPasquale opened the Town Board meeting held at 103 Main Street, Mount Morris, NY.

Accountant McKerrow informed the Board that this proposed Tentative Budget is only \$8100 over the state tax cap. The salary increase in the new union contract is 4.5%, so she has applied that across the budget. The Board then reviewed the proposed tentative budget line by line, and considered adjustments.

The Clerk suggested moving some of the Town Clerk's service and contractual expenses from A1410 to the Records Management lines since much of the work is related to this duty, and the state will look at these appropriations when applying for records management grants.

Accountant McKerrow stated that CHIPS funding was higher this year so that helped Fund DB. We need to keep an eye on line DA599, unexpended fund balance.

Ambulance revenue has been down in both 2020 and 2021, due to COVID. The Board should consider applying for ARPA funding due to this loss in revenue.

The next budget meeting was scheduled for 5:00 Thursday October 7, 2021.

A motion by Supervisor DiPasquale, seconded by Councilmember Huff, to adjourn this meeting.
