Transfer Station Reports- Rates

Clerk Woodworth brought to the boards attention that the bid we sent out for dumpster services for the transfer station was incorrect. In the bid it asks for residential garbage pickup. Clerk Woodworth is concerned that the town may have not received many quotes due to this. Residential garbage service would be impractical in a Town.

Councilmember Guzzardi said that we needed to call Casella's and Scofield's and get a quote from them. He felt that the vote should be tabled until we get more bids. The board agreed.

Clerk informed the board that E waste Plus advised that a new law is coming out from the state that makes it illegal for refuse centers to charge for electronics to be disposed. E-Waste said that they would be able to take electronics from the Town starting in January.
